

Environmental Policy Statement

Pre-Heat recognises the importance of safety and environmental management and the impact of its activities within the heating, social housing and building industry.

The overall aim of this Statement is to set out the Policy objectives, which Pre-Heat will seek to achieve by good management practice and the application of legislative requirements, industry Codes of Practice and Company Standards where applicable. The following Policy objectives will apply to all offices and operational work sites managed by Pre-Heat.

- Reduce, where practicable, the environmental effect of our activities to minimise the potential for pollution, minimise waste production and ensure the efficient use of resources;
- Minimise environmental disturbance including nuisance from noise, dust and traffic
- Comply with all current environmental legislation and seek to meet future legislative provisions;
- Seek, wherever reasonably practicable to implement waste management procedures that promote the recycling of materials within the supply chain
- Promote energy efficiency;
- Integrate environmental issues into all aspects of decision making processes within the company;
- Address environmental issues within normal operating procedures;
- Develop and implement emergency response procedures to minimise the environmental impact of incidents;
- Seek to ensure that our clients and major suppliers are aware of and apply environmental standards compatible with our own
- Take account of environmental considerations when selecting plant or equipment
- Ensure continuous improvement in environmental performance with the development of a comprehensive Environmental Management System that encompasses the fundamental principles of ISO14001.
